
Sally Madsen

Helping people be healthy

It's our goal at Campobello **Health Centre** to help you maintain or improve your current state of health.

What's new?

Respiratory Health – Using spirometry, we screen residents who have risk factors for COPD and offer clinical follow-up or education depending on diagnosis. COPD is a priority health issue on the island. Patients may receive action plans to assist with self-management.

Diabetes Management – Upon diagnosis by the doctor or NP, nurses work with you to provide education and tips on how to manage your diabetes on a daily basis. Patients between the ages of 40 and 74 will also be screened for being at risk for developing diabetes.

Follow-up Phone Calls – Patients of Campobello who have been in hospital now receive a follow-up phone call after discharge unless they already have a scheduled follow-up appointment. We want to ensure you're following our advice, taking your medications and making good use of service providers such as homemakers. A top reason patients are readmitted to hospital is that an appropriate and timely follow-up call was not made to ensure they're doing well.

Smoking Cessation – We regularly ask smokers if they would like our support to quit smoking. It's the number 1 service we can offer to improve a smoker's health.

Sexual Health Services - Campobello offers sexual health services for

Methadone Support Program – We assist with screening and supporting patients who are receiving maintenance methadone therapy.




