



## **How to Clean Your Spacer**

**1**. Take your spacer apart.




- 2. Place in warm, clean water (with 1 squirt of liquid dish soap or vinegar).
- 3. Do not put anything in your spacer to clean it.
- 4. Soak for 15 minutes.
- **5**. Swish the spacer in the water for a few seconds.






- 6. Rinse in clean water.
- 7. Shake off any water.
- **8**. Do not dry the inside of the spacer with a towel.
- **9**. Allow parts to air dry.





**10**. Put your spacer back together lining up the holes.





- **11**. Your spacer should be washed once a week.
- **12**. Store your spacer with your puffer at all times.
- **13**. Your spacer should be replaced every 1-2 years.
